MEDIUM TERM PLAN

MATHEMATICS

In Mathematics we will be learning about, Identifying and describing the properties of 3-D shapes, including the number of edges, vertices and faces.

Identify 2-D shapes on the surface of 3-D shapes, [for example, a circle on a cylinder and a triangle on a pyramid].

Compare and sort common 2-D and 3-D shapes and everyday objects.

Use mathematical vocabulary to describe position, direction and movement, including movement in a straight line and distinguishing between rotation as a turn and in terms of right angles for quarter, $\frac{1}{2}$ and $\frac{3}{4}$ turns (clockwise and anti-clockwise).
Data Handling: Interpret and construct simple pictograms, tally charts, block diagrams and simple tables.

Ask and answer simple questions by counting the number of objects in each category and sorting the categories by quantity.

MATHEMATICS – BASIC SKILLS

The children will:

- recall multiplication and division facts for tables up to 12 x2, 5 and 10
- solve addition and subtraction two step problems in contexts, deciding which operation and method to use

ENGLISH

SIGNIFICANT AUTHORS: JULIA DONALDSON

Children will write a sustained story independently.

They will focus on:

- composing compound sentences and using subordination.
- using a logical sequences of events.
- consistent use of the third person and past tense.

They will:

Plan, draft, edit and review their work.

SPELLING

Pupils will be taught to add suffixes to spell longer words, including –ment, -ness, -ful, -less, -ly

SCIENCE

Habitats

The children will be taught:
To explore and compare the differences between
things that are living, dead, and things that have
never been alive
Identify that most living things live in habitats to
which they are suited and describe how different
habitats provide for the basic needs of different kinds
of animals and plants, and how they depend on each
other.

HISTORY

The children will develop an awareness of
the past, using common words and phrases
relating to the passing of time. They will
learn where the people and events they
study fit within a chronological framework
and identify similarities and differences
between ways of life in different periods.
They will learn a wide vocabulary of everyday
historical terms. They will also learn to ask
and answer questions, choosing and using
parts of stories and other sources to show
that they know and understand key features
of events. They will understand some of the
ways in which we find out about the past and
identify different ways in which it is
represented.
