MEDIUM TERM PLAN

MATHEMATICS

In Mathematics we will be learning about Statistics.

They will be able to interpret and construct simple pictograms, tally charts, block diagrams and tables.

Ask and answer simple questions by counting the number of objects in each category and sorting the categories by quality.

Ask and answer questions about totalling and comparing categorical data.

MATHEMATICS – BASIC SKILLS

The children will:

- recall multiplication and division facts for tables up to 12 x2, 3, 5 and 10
- solve addition and subtraction two step problems in contexts, deciding which operation and method to use

ENGLISH

Study a Significant Author

The children will:

Produce and publish work applying all their learning.

They will dramatise a scene from one of the stories they have written.

They will present to the class who then will evaluate the performance and make constructive comments.

SPELLING

Pupils will be taught to add suffixes to spell longer words, including –ment, -ness, -ful, -less, -ly
