



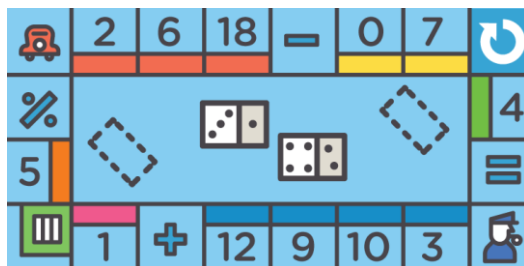

MATHEMATICS

In Mathematics we will be learning about: Number and Place Value, Maths Games, Maths Puzzles, Problem Solving and Investigations.



MATHEMATICS – BASIC SKILLS

The children will:
-recall multiplication and division facts for tables up to 12 x2, 3, 5 and 10
-solve addition and subtraction two step problems in contexts, deciding which operation and method to use

ENGLISH

The children will:
Produce and publish work applying all their learning.

SPELLING

Pupils will be taught to add suffixes to spell longer words, including –ment, -ness, -ful, -less, -ly

ENGLISH

Non Chronological Reports

The children will:
understand about writing for different purposes.
consider what they are going to write before they begin.
They will plan what they are going to write about.

Use appropriate vocabulary.

-Write their Non Chronological Report encapsulating what they want to say, sentence by sentence
-Plan, draft, edit and review

GRAMMAR AND PUNCTUATION
