

The Summer term's focus in Religious Education is about the role the Holy Spirit plays in our lives. This will be explored through the themes of ***Pentecost, Reconciliation and the Universal Church***. We will also spend one week finding out about another World religion - Sikhism.

PENTECOST – SERVING

(start of term – 17th May)



In the first topic, the children will focus on the on-going mission of Jesus in the church through the power of the Holy Spirit.

Suggestions for home activities

Talk about good news in your family and how you share it. Ask your child to tell you the story of Pentecost and the work of the Holy Spirit.

OTHER WORLD RELIGION

SIHKISM

(20th – 24th May)

Each year group will be learning about a different aspect of the beliefs and practices of the followers of Sikhism.



At home, ask children to tell you what they have found out – perhaps research or share some other information too.

RECONCILIATION – INTER-RELATING

(4th – 28th June)



In the next topic, we will focus on the love, compassion and forgiveness of God the Father, revealed in Jesus and poured out by the Spirit to bring forgiveness through the sacrament of Reconciliation.

Suggestions for home activities

Talk together about times when you have forgiven and been forgiven. Discuss the importance of saying sorry. Look for opportunities for forgiveness and reconciliation in the day to day life of your family.

UNIVERSAL CHURCH - WORLD

(2nd July – end of term)



The final topic of the term focuses on the same love revealed in the diversity of the world and its people, and in the gifts of the Spirit that are demonstrated in the values of love, joy, justice and peace for all people.

Suggestions for home activities

Together, look through photos of a visit to a place that is special for your family. Look at a map and find a special place. Discuss how we can look after our world and support our neighbours, near and far.


