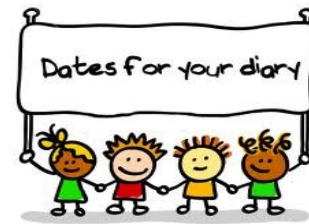



Qwell.io is a free safe and anonymous online wellbeing platform, that is now available for adults in Liverpool (26+).

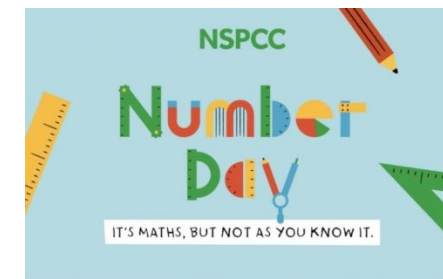
