

The children will be playing Bingo within their class bubbles, so this is open to all our children. £2.50 a ticket including games of Bingo, hot dog, drink and sweets.


If you haven't already paid for your ticket you can pay on Monday. Please send the money in with your child in an envelope with their name written on the front.
