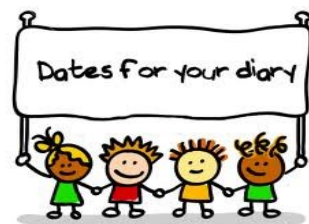

Message from United Utilities.

You may already be aware we are currently carrying out works in the area to replace the old water pipes with new ones. This project in November 2021 and expect to be completed by July 2022. I have attached a map which shows the streets/roads that we have, and will be working along.
