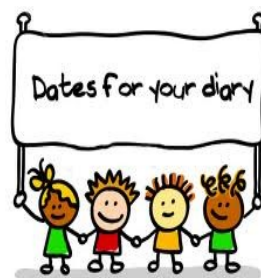

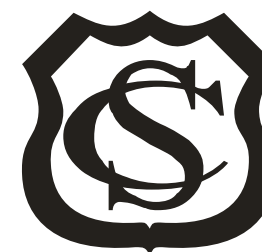
United Utilities Water Improvement Works

Message from United Utilities.

You may already be aware we are currently carrying out works in the area to replace the old water pipes with new ones. We started this project in November 2021 and expect to be completed by July 2022. I have attached a map which shows the streets/roads that we have, and will be working along.

We need to replace the water pipes along Tramway Road, we plan to start this work from the middle of March. This will impact on road parking and will cause disruption for parents during school drop off and pick up times.

We understand our works can cause inconvenience and we will do our best to keep disruption to a minimum.
