ST CHARLES' CATHOLIC PRIMARY SCHOOL UNIFORM POLICY

It is school policy for all pupils to wear school uniform and parents are asked to support the school in maintaining a high standard of appearance.

WINTER UNIFORM

RECEPTION, Y1 AND Y2

Pale blue shirt/blouse
Grey shorts/skirt/pinafore
Maroon tie
Maroon jumper/cardigan with school logo
Grey/maroon/white socks
Black shoes (not black trainers)

Y3-Y6

Pale blue shirt/blouse
Grey trousers/skirt/pinafore
Maroon tie
Maroon jumper/cardigan with school logo
Grey/maroon/white socks
Black shoes (not black trainers)

SUMMER UNIFORM

BOYS:

Pale blue polo shirts with school logo Grey shorts (Infants), Grey trousers or shorts (Juniors) Maroon jumper with school logo Grey socks Black shoes (not black trainers)

GIRLS:

Pale blue gingham dress Maroon cardigan with school logo White socks White or black shoes (not trainers)

PE KIT

Maroon shorts
Pale blue T-shirt

Black plimsolls (pumps) or trainers

Blue hoodies may be worn as part of PE but should not be worn in class instead of the maroon school jumper.

PE Kits can be worn to school on PE day

All pupils are requested to have their PE pumps/trainers in school each day to wear indoors.

Maroon school coats with school logo are recommended.

Long hair should be tied back – hair bands or ribbons should be of school colours (maroon/pale blue).

Jewellery may not be worn, with the exception of a watch.

If ears are pierced, only small studs may be worn.

All clothing should be labelled with the child's name.

School cannot be held responsible for uniform that is lost when it is not labelled.

Infant pupils may wear school jogging bottoms over their shorts when travelling to school in cold weather. These will be able to be removed once in the classroom.

Blue hoodies may be worn as part of PE but should not be worn in class instead of the maroon school jumper.

In sunny weather, children may need a sun hat.

Ties and book bags are available to buy at the school office.

All other school uniform can be bought at Kitted Out uniform suppliers.
