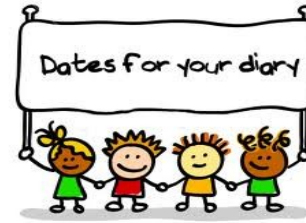

## Science Week

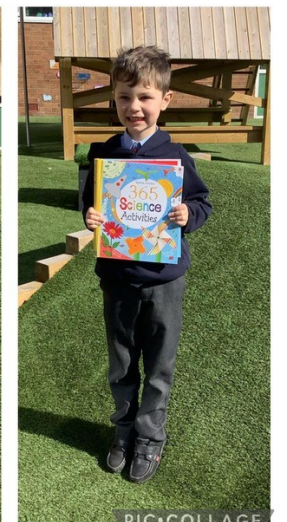
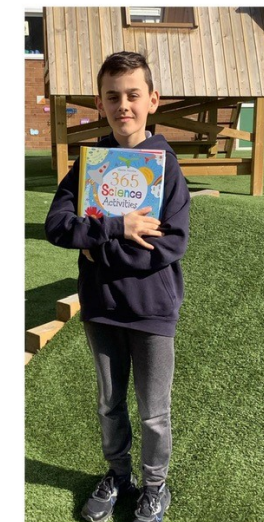
