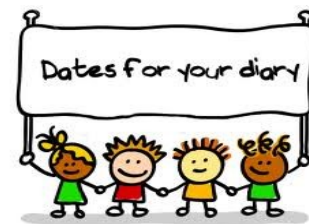


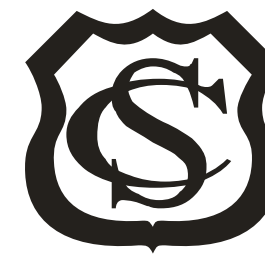

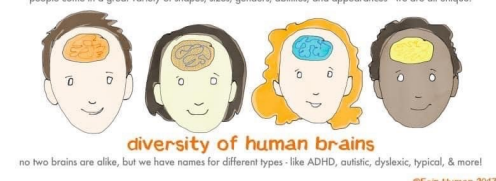


### Odd Socks Day

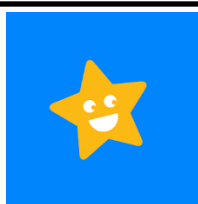
