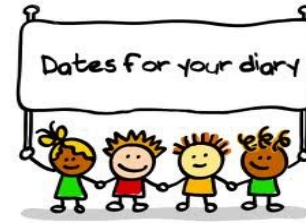

### Early Years Quality Mark

This week we had an assessor in school to reassess that we still meet their criteria. We are delighted to share that we **PASSED**. Thank you to our wonderful children, staff, parents and governors. Here is a little snippet from the report.

"Continuous provision was observed to be well considered with a wide range of opportunities freely available to children to support their acquisition of basic skills. The indoor space offers a cosy and welcoming reading area, enhanced with lights and a selection of quality texts. There are also puppets and props for children to use to retell familiar and shared stories. In addition, there is a well-stocked maths area which children accessed confidently and independently during the learning walk. The children were excited to participate in challenges set by the teacher and could talk about what they were doing. One child, while using the maths resources, enthusiastically announced- 'I just want to do some learning' before sequencing some number patterns and finding the correct corresponding numerals. Children are proud of their achievements and adults support them sensitively.

The assessor thanks the children spoken to for their enthusiasm and to the parents who took the time to speak so positively about their experience of the school's approach, not only to teaching and learning but to nurturing and caring for their children. "



### COVID UPDATE

From 1st April, routine testing will no longer be expected in all education and children's settings.
