### Parking Around School

Reminder - it's always illegal to park on yellow zig-zag lines anywhere. Rule 243 of the Highway Code indicates a range of places where motorists must not park, it states that drivers "Must not park near a school entrance".



Parking outside a school specifically, may obstruct visibility for parents and children trying to cross the road and is therefore highly dangerous. This could result in a fine of £100 and an endorsement of three penalty points on your license.



- Support from NASS (National Asylum Support Service) under part 6 of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- The quarantee element of State Pension Credit
- Child Tax Credit, Working Tax Credit run-on, Universal Credit.


