Parking Around School

Reminder - it's always illegal to park on yellow zig-zag lines anywhere. Rule 243 of the Highway Code indicates a range of places where motorists must not park, it states that drivers **"Must not park near a school entrance"**.

Parking outside a school specifically, may obstruct visibility for parents and children trying to cross the road and is therefore highly dangerous. **This could result in a fine of £100 and an endorsement of three penalty points on your license.**

Nursery Places

Did you know your child can begin attending our Nursery as soon as they turn 3?

Let me explain... All children receive funding for 15 hrs per week the term following their 3rd birthday, but are eligible to come to Nursery the day after their 3rd birthday, through a self funded pathway. This means you can pay our nursery fees to bridge the gap between their third birthday and the following term when their funding begins.

Brilliant news!

There is also a **30 hr extended childcare** offer available for working parents; it is worth looking into this to see if you're eligible.
