

Nursery Places

Did you know your child can begin attending our Nursery as soon as they turn 3?

Let me explain... All children receive funding for 15 hrs per week the term following their 3rd



birthday, but are eligible to come to Nursery the day after their 3rd birthday, through a self funded pathway. This means you can pay our nursery fees to bridge the gap between their 3rd birthday and the following term when their funding begins. Brilliant news!

There is also a 30 hr extended childcare offer available for working parents; it is worth looking into this to see if you're eligible.
